I agree that this waiver, release and indemnification agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of California and/or San Bernardino County, and if any portion hereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance hereof shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

1. In order to participate in Homework Help, registration is required and must be completed by a parent or guardian of each student.
2. Tutors will only assist with school assigned homework only during Homework Help hours.
3. Homework Help is Kindergarten through Eighth grades.
4. Subject help is in English and Math. Additional subject help and bilingual help is subject to tutor availability and is not guaranteed.
5. Students will receive 15 minutes of Homework Help. If there are no other students waiting, students may receive more time. Extra time is not guaranteed.
6. Students may borrow supplies and are responsible for returning them before leaving Homework Help.
7. Students and parent/guardians must remain respectful to other students, volunteers, and staff at all times.
8. Students are expected to focus on their schoolwork. Inability to do so will require tutors to help the next student waiting for Homework Help.
9. Students and tutors are allowed to use online resources when working on homework. We do not encourage looking up answers.
10. Parent/guardians must remain inside the library while their child is in Homework Help. However, they may not assist in Homework Help.
11. Students and parent/guardians must follow San Bernardino Public Library Policy.
12. Students and parent/guardians who are not following Homework Help rules or San Bernardino Public Library Policy will be asked to leave. Repeated or more severe incidents will result in a suspension from Homework Help services and/or San Bernardino Public Library.
